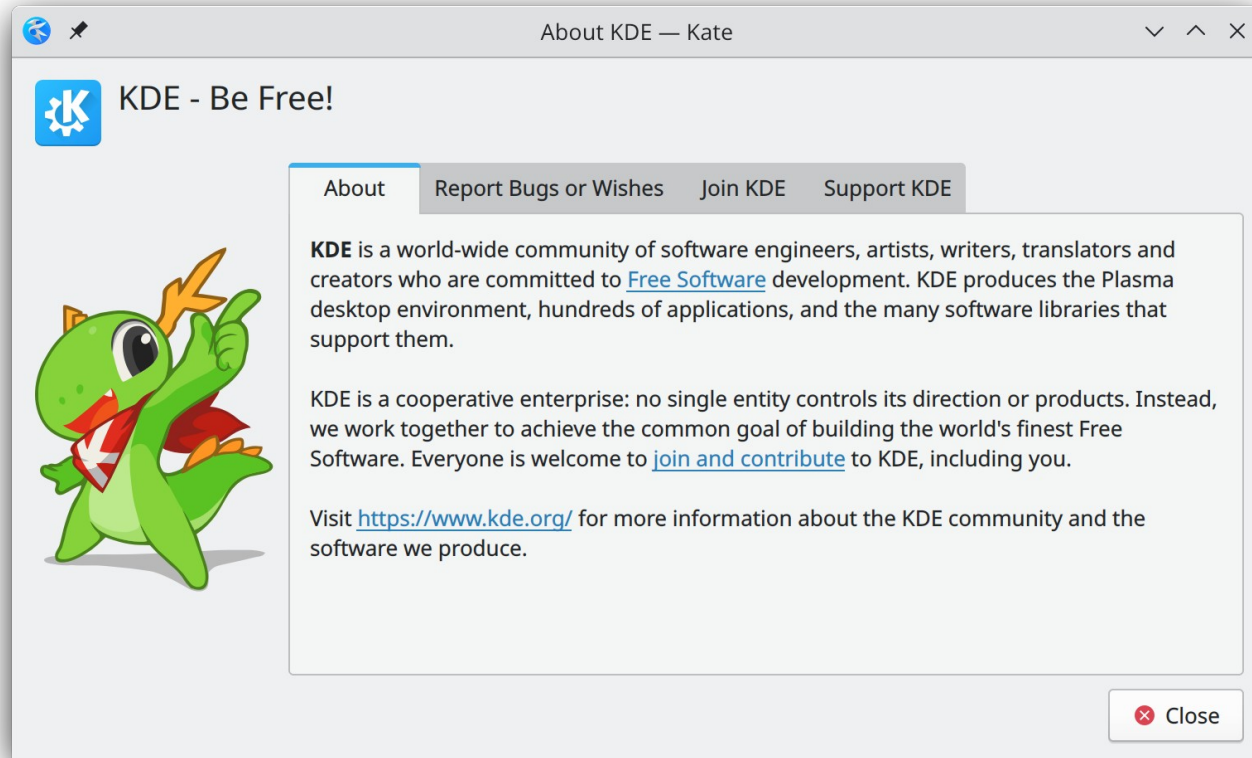

- All KDE things are based on Qt5
- Some date back to 1996 and Qt1
- Regular contributors to Qt
- KDE Free Qt Foundation safeguards

Previous Goals: All about the Apps, Wayland, Consistency, Onboarding, Usability and Productivity, Privacy

KDE's Codebase

- KDE has a lot of code: ~15 Million LOC
- Virtually all C++, Qt5, QML
- Many independent subprojects
- Multi-generational
- Both QtWidgets and QML
- Graphics-intensive applications
- CMake buildsystem

KDE Frameworks

- 80+ modular libraries based on Qt
- Common functionality not found in Qt
- Available to external users
- Stable API/ABI
- Qt6 means new major version for KDE Frameworks

Kickoff

- First planning session at Akademy 2019
- KDE Frameworks 6 sprint in 2019 (with virtual David Faure)



Frameworks 6 Design Goals

- Easy porting
- Delay branching as much as possible
- Improve APIs
- Drop unused stuff
- Separate Core/Widgets/QML
- Improve cross-platform support
- Separate interface and implementation

Initial porting experiments

- 2019-2020: Preparation work
- First porting experiments in late 2020
- “Probieren geht über studieren”
- Typical issues:
 - Missing Qt modules
 - Missing includes
 - Qt6 is stricter in some cases
 - Changed signatures

Build System

- Late 2021 we tackled the build system
- `s/5/6/` works well for plain porting
- Version-less targets/functions are helpful
- But not suitable for libraries
- Worst case: `Qt${QT_MAJOR_VERSION}::Core`
- Some things need further adaption (e.g. `Qt5Compat`, `QtX11Extras`)

Problems

- QTextCodec
- QStringRef, QRegExp
- Platform Extras Modules
- Shaders
- QML
- QtGraphicalEffects

Status

- No Qt6-based releases
- <https://iskdeusingqt6.org> tracks progress
- QML porting still to be done
- KDE Frameworks 6 will be branched in December
- Plasma 6 development starts in January

- QAction in QtGui
- New QtMultimedia
- Improved QML/QtQuick
